CHILD CARE - Before School Care is available daily from 6:45-8:45 AM. After School Care is available immediately following dismissal until 6:15PM. Afternoon care for our Preschool students is held Monday through Thursday from 12:00-3:45 PM. <u>Child care for early releases or days off requires</u> advance registration. If you desire child care for such days you must contact the office by noon the day prior.

FREE MILK is available to students of families who qualify based on household size and income. Please

see the accompanying letter to determine if you may apply. Applications should be submitted promptly but no later than <u>September 30^{th} </u>. They are available throughout the year if there is a need.

DRESS CODE - The student's dress should reflect good judgment and moderation. Shorts may be worn until October 31st. More in depth information regarding the dress code will be discussed at Back to School Night.

MARKET DAY – Concordia participates in this program on a monthly basis. Order forms for topnotch, delicious and nutritious food items came home earlier this week. Did you check yours out??
