PRIVATE SCHOOL TUITION? The tuition tax deduction is NEW in Wisconsin. Parents/guardians are eligible for a maximum deduction of \$4,000/child in grades K-8 and \$10,000/child in grades 9-12. Students transitioning from eighth grade to ninth grade are eligible for both deductions. Per the instructions, any amount spent on tuition and book fees are eligible for the deduction. All expenses incurred after January 1, 2014, are eligible for the deduction. Attached to this newsletter is a draft of tax schedule for your reference.
