**ARRIVING EARLY** – Thank you for your faithfulness in observing the school start time of 8:50 a.m. Students that arrive prior to 8:40 a.m. will need to proceed to Before Care if a parent/guardian is not present. Students that enter in childcare after 8:30 a.m. will not be billed. **However, arrivals to Before Care prior to that time will be billed on the half hour.**

**PARKING LOT PROTOCOL** – For the safety of all we require cars to enter on Durand and exit on Corliss. This is especially critical at arrival and dismissal times. When dropping off children, **please do not park or stop for extended periods in front of or along the side of the sidewalk at the school entry.** This creates hazardous backups due to restricted traffic flow. When entering, exiting, or moving through the lot at any time of day, **move SLOWLY! Use extreme caution when getting out of or into vehicles** as others may be preparing to park or entering and exiting vehicles. Finally, please **only park in spots designated by lines** to assist us in avoiding bottlenecked areas. **Please be aware of your surroundings and follow these requirements for the safety of all!**
