GET READY TO REAPPLY (OR APPLY) FOR A VOUCHER

New and returning students may begin applying for a voucher to attend Concordia beginning **February 1**. The first application period will continue through February 20, The process requires the parent to complete an online application(<https://apps4.dpi.wi.gov/ChoiceParent/Login/Login.aspx>) and submit income information (new students only) along with residency documentation (all students) brought to the school during the Feb. 1 – Feb. 20 window. **CONTINUING STUDENTS must reapply and provide residency documentation in February to be assured of retaining the seat they currently hold at Concordia.** Opportunities for families to reapply or make application at the school with assistance will be held on Friday, February 2, from 12:00 – 4:00 p.m., Mon., February 5 from 7:30– 8:30 a.m., Thurs, February 8 from 4:30 – 5:30 p.m., Tues. Feb. 13th from 4:30 – 5:30 p.m. Sat. Feb. 17 from 10 a.m. – NOON and Mon. Feb. 19 from 7:30 – 8:30 a.m. Bring the required documents with you! Call the school office at 262-884-0991 with questions.
