REAPPLYING FOR A CHOICE VOUCHER FOR **2016-17** Private School Choice applications for students will be accepted and verified beginning February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016. Parents of continuing students should go online to the Department of Public Instruction website and reapply during the February application period (Feb. 1 - 22). In order to have that application verified the supporting documentation (a current WE Energies bill preferred) must be brought to the school office during that timeframe. CONTINUING STUDENTS must reapply and provide residency documentation to be assured of retaining the seat they currently hold at Concordia. 
